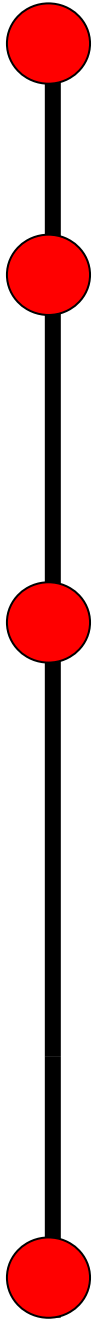

Danycoed Halt

- Recreated typical BR(W) halt, with pagoda shelter.
- Watch your locomotive run around it's train, ready for the return journey.

Llwyfan Cerrig

- Carriage & Wagon workshop open for viewing - TVR 220 will be visible, 'in the shops' for work.
- Travelling Post Office coach open for viewing
- Display stands from The Welsh Train Project (TVR No.28) and the Gwili Vintage Carriage Group (GVCG).
- TVR No.28 on static display in the yard - footplate open.

Bronwydd Arms

- Intensive timetable - lots of movements to see!
- Footplate rides on class 03 D2178 (at selected times: 1030-1200, then 1320-1400).
- 3.5"/5" gauge miniature railway, operated by the Pembrokeshire Portable Track (small charge).
- Permanent way department display in the carpark.
- Photographic display, showing the extension project through the years.
- Trade and display stands in the carpark (weather permitting).
- S&T Museum open, in the signalbox at the far end of the carpark.
- Cafe open all day (in the Victorian coach bodies, next to the signalbox).
- Bus link to model railway show, in Bronwydd Village Hall (organised by the West Wales 'O' Gauge group - small extra charge).

Abergwili Junction

- Our newest station! Accessible by rail only.

Where to eat and drink....

The Victorian Tearoom will be open at Bronwydd Arms station (next to the signalbox) - serving hot drinks, rolls and cakes throughout the day.

On board the main passenger train (shown as set 'A' on the timetable), the bar coach will be open - serving drinks/crisps etc.

Toilets are available on all trains, and at both Bronwydd Arms and Llwyfan Cerrig stations.
